

Message of Vice-Chancellor



I am pleased to present the Annual Report 2024-25 of Central University of South Bihar (CUSB) which is documenting the one-year progress report of the University. Under my leadership the exemplary work done by the University administration, officials, with the combined efforts of the faculty members, research scholars and the students CUSB achieved new milestones. CUSB has been awarded with the prestigious DST-PURSE (Promotion of University Research and Scientific Excellence) research grant of Rs. 7.13 crore in 2024 by the Ministry of Science & Technology, Government of India to enhance its research ecosystem. The Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India under the Fund for Improvement of S&T Infrastructure (FIST) scheme awarded ₹2.72 Crore to the Department of Chemistry of CUSB. The well-equipped Department of Environmental Science (EVS) received a massive funding of Rs. 1.10 crore from the Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India under the DST Fund for Improvement of S&T Infrastructure (FIST) scheme. In addition to these, the faculty members of various departments received combined research grants over Rs. 1 crore from different funding agencies to perform the high-quality research that may help in new findings (innovation) as well as policy making and contribute towards *Viksit Bharat* (Developed India). I am happy to share that the fourth convocation of the University was held on March 20, 2025. His Excellency Governor of Bihar Honorable Mr. Arif Mohammad Khan graced the occasion as the Chief Guest and delivered the convocation address. The Governor of Bihar awarded the gold medals to 80 students who topped in undergraduate (UG) and postgraduate courses. A total of 1346 students who passed Undergraduate (UG) and Post Graduate (PG) and PhD in the year 2021 and 2022 were awarded the degree certificates. The events and activities, seminars, workshops and conferences, celebration of special days of national importance, fortnight celebration like 'Swachhata Pakhwada' on birth anniversary Mahatma Gandhi, etc. kept the campus vibrant and lively. The adrenaline gushing sports tournaments at the University level and participation of students in the state and national level competitions also deserve special mention here as they helped to maintain a perfect balance between healthy mind and body. The University is progressing on the path of 'Academic Excellence' since its establishment and we are committed to bring more laurels in the coming year.

Central University of South Bihar at a Glance

About the University

The Central University of South Bihar (CUSB) is established under the Central Universities Act, 2009 (section 25 of 2009) as Central University of Bihar (name changed under the Central Universities Amendment Act, 2014). The University is functioning from the 300 acres sprawling campus at Panchanpur, about 15kms. from Gaya Railway Station, on Gaya -Panchanpur Road (National Highway No. 120). The University is accredited with 'A++' grade / 3.58 CGPA by the NAAC in 2023, and succeeded in getting the Category – 1 University Rank from the UGC in 2024, and placed in rank bank of 151-200 in NIRF Ranking 2025. With the combined efforts of the University fraternity and its stake-holders, CUSB has maintained its excellence in Academia and achieved a respectable position in the rankings carried out by different government and private agencies. The University welcomes visitors with a grand Entrance Plaza and further provides visual delight with a half-globe shaped Stupa and a magnificent multi-storied Administrative Block building. Besides, three massive Schools buildings namely (i) School of Earth, Biological and Environmental Sciences named as Aryabhatta Bhawan, (ii) School of Social Sciences and Policy named as Chanakya Bhawan and (iii) School of Education building named as Malaviya Bhawan, and other buildings namely, Vivekanand Lecture Complex, Sangharam Guest House, VD Savarkar Boys Hostel, Maitreyi Sadan Girls Hostel and Gargi Sadan Girls Hostel, Madhuvan Food Court altogether are like visual treat for visitors, and offering a pristine environs for running academic and co-curricular activities. Along with world-class highly qualified faculty members, high teacher-student ratio, following the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 in its curriculum, baskets full of elective courses in different programmes, the University offers Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) with total internal evaluation of students' performance at Undergraduate (UG), Postgraduate (PG) and PhD levels. Other highlights of CUSB includes a conducive and research-oriented environment with multidisciplinary approach, innovative pedagogies, promising infrastructural facilities and effective students' support system to nurture students' personality in a holistic manner and to prepare them for a bright future.

Vision of the University

The Collective reasoning of this University is committed for a better tomorrow and we strive together to create an eco-system where best minds holding high human and moral values interact to constantly chase perfection in frontline research and teaching to provide younger generations a platform for realizing their potentials to serve humanity with compassion.



Facilities at CUSB

The University puts its best efforts to offer a passable atmosphere for learning and high-quality research activities to the students and faculty members. The well-stocked library, computer centres with contemporary facilities like Wi-Fi, state-of-the-art laboratories with delicate to heavy equipments, smart class rooms, conference rooms, playground, etc. altogether makes the University a perfect abode for academia and impress the outside world a lot and helps in earning plaudits in the form of Rankings carried out by different agencies of the country.

Rajarshi Janak Central Library

The 1st fully automated library in the state of Bihar, the Central Library is spread in an area of 4094 sq. metre with good collection of Title of latest edition of books in sufficient volumes, standard national and international journals. The library has more than 53,000 books to support academic curricula, teaching & research in various science and social science subjects. The library subscribes to over 13,000 Journals (Peer reviewed) and hundreds of magazines. Library services include circulation (issue/return) of books, Inter-Library Loan through DELNET, New Delhi, Current Awareness Service (CAS) for books and journals, photocopy, etc. Users can search the availability of books in library using OPAC, current status of books, due date of return, reserve/hold book, etc. Access to electronic resources is available for students, faculty and officials on their computer within the university premises. Recently, access to these resources has been extended through Virtual Private Network (VPN). 24 x 7 reference service is also being provided through CUSB Virtual Reference Platform. The fully automated RFID system 'Save the time of Users' and reduces the amount of time required to perform circulation operations of the library such as issuing and returning of books can be fully automatized with the help of self check-in and check-out systems. It has other highlights such as account station, anti-theft detection, book dropbox, ability to locate specific items and automated Email to the user on every issue or return operation. It has other benefits like improving library workflow, reducing non-value-added work processes, improves staff productivity, improves user service of the library, etc. There is also the facility for remote access of CUSB subscribed e-Resources through MyLOFT application software for their users. Through the application all CUSB subscribed e-Resources such as e-journals, e-books, e-databases have been integrated with a centralised access point and with a single username and password. The users can access these e-Resources remotely on their PC, Laptop, Mobile Phone as well as on Tablet.

Central Computing Facility (University Computer Centre)

The Central Computing facility is offered with sufficient numbers of desktops / laptops attached with printer / Xerox facilities at almost all work desks. The Computer Laboratory provides a central computing facility to the faculty members, researchers as well as students for their assignments, projects, dissertation and research related works. In Computer Lab, printing and scanning facilities are also available. Teachers are also provided with individual desktop / laptop with personal as well as pool printer to assist them in preparing for their lectures and take up their research pursuits. All computers are equipped with latest and legal operating system and application software to cater to the academic needs. Computers are protected by firewall and reliable antivirus software against computer virus, malware and unauthorized access. Internet facility through LAN as well as Wi-Fi connectivity is provided to departments /centres, library, class rooms, administrative building and other sections. The University has powerful E-mail system with group mail IDs of students, faculty members and staff.



Laboratories

Most of the departments have its own laboratory equipped with equipment and latest instruments for conducting practicals of students and research scholars. The departments of Biotechnology, Geology, Pharmacy, Life Science, Environmental Science, Physics, Chemistry, Mass Communication, etc. have well – furnished laboratories.

Jeevak Health Centre

The University has its Health Centre, which provides primary level treatment to faculty, staff and students for general ailments under the supervision of Medical officer.

Psychological Counselling Service

Like physical health, mental health determines efficiency and productivity, which is critically important for teaching-learning process, creativity, and congenial environment in academic institutions. The University adopts a forward-looking approach and institutes psychological counselling and guidance for students, faculty and employees under the supervision of expert time-to-time or on need basis.

Exclusive Facilities for Students

The University believes that the students are future of the country and they deserve extra care to pursue their studies without any hassle. The University is committed to offer the best possible amenities to students so that they can study and carry on research work with complete peace of mind for a better outcome. Some of the facilities specifically provided to students are mentioned below under separate heads:

Governance & E-Governance: The University is following a decentralised and participative system of governance to achieve the mandate stated in the Act and Statues. Faculty members are directly involved in decision-making bodies of the University, which in turn helps the students in a great way for redressal of their grievances. Each department of the University has a Departmental Committee and it takes the decisions for academic proposals at initial state before being placed before Apex decision-making bodies of the University. The Board of Studies (BOS) is also an important body of the department which specifically looks after the curriculum development work. Also, the University has put its efforts towards the use of E-Governance tools to bring effectiveness into its administration to promote transparency and efficiency in the system.

Semester System: The Semester System is followed in all Academic programmes (courses) of the University to enhance the curricular space and encourage the accelerated learning opportunities.

Choice Based Credit System (CBCS): The CBCS System facilitates the students to have vertical integration of knowledge and holistic development.

Evaluation System: Continuous internal evaluation is carried out in the University by the faculty members to assess the performance of the students. The University has developed appropriate mechanism to ensure transparency and accountability in the internal assessments and End-Semester evaluations.

Scholarship Schemes: All research scholars (Ph.D.) students get UGC scholarship. In addition to Centre government and state government funded scholarships, the University offers a number of scholarship schemes to deserving and needy students, namely (i) Merit Scholarship to CUET / Semester Toppers (ii) Merit-cum-Means Scholarship (iii) Earn While You Learn (EWYL) Scheme & (iv) Attendance Based Merit Scholarship.

Vidyarthi Mediclaim Policy: All the students of the University are insured under this scheme. This is a unique policy of National Insurance Company (NIC) designed to provide health and personal accident cover to the students. Under this scheme the students are eligible for cashless treatment in authorized hospitals as well as for reimbursement of cost of treatment in other hospitals within the limit of Rs. 50,000.

Admission through CUET: The Admission to various programmes (courses) of the University is made through national level entrance test jointly conducted for the Central Universities called Central Universities Entrance Test (CUET). With its transparent and national level admission process, the University has succeeded to attract the students from different states and maintaining the diversity & national character efficiently.

Boys & Girls Hostels for Accommodations: Presently the University offers accommodation to students with one (1) Boys Hostel and two (2) Girls Hostel having combined capacity to accommodate around 1400 students. Mess facility is also available for students residing in the hostels on payment basis.



Sports & Co-curricular Activities: The University has a huge sports complex named as 'Milkha Singh Sports Complex' where various sports activities are conducted for students round the year. Usually the sports activities are conducted by the Games and Sports Activities Committee. The students of the University participate in the state and nation level competitions and events under the supervision of co-ordinators of the committees and win many competitions with their brilliant performances.

Internships: Keeping in view the importance of role of practice-based learning / first-hand industry experience the University provides internship opportunities to the students during Summer vacation.

Campus Placements: The University has a Career Counselling and Placement Cell which takes care of the campus placements and job opportunities for the students. Many students got job placement during the session 2024-25 in organisations like Azim Premji Foundation, Care India (NGO), Gandhi Fellowship - Piramal Foundation, etc. Students from Media department got placements in Times of India, Hindustan Times, ETV Bharat, Hindustan Dainik and Prabhat Khabar and along with many other organisations.

Quality Management through IQAC: The University is having an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) to ensure progressive improvement in efficiency of the functioning of the institution.

Proctorial Board: The board is responsible to maintain discipline among the students of University and it functions under supervision of the Chief Proctor. The Proctorial board takes preventive steps to maintain the discipline within the University premises, issues the notices and warnings as per need of the situation.

Dean Students' Welfare: The Dean Students' Welfare (DSW) is shouldering the responsibility of looking after the general welfare of students outside classrooms, in order to ensure all round development. The office of DSW also performs the duties and functions viz. (i) make arrangements for educational tours, excursions and participation in sports activities outside the University (ii) conduct social and cultural activities (iii) form of student bodies (iv) evaluate student – teacher relationship (v) examine and recommend for financial aid to needy students and concession for travel, and other facilities (vi) facilitate fellowships / scholarships for further studies in the country or abroad (vii) student counselling (viii) provide special assistance (if required) to differently abled students or women students (ix) provide Student information services (x) organise alumni association (xii) issue certificates as authorised and delegated by the Vice-Chancellor.

04th Convocation Ceremony of CUSB – 20th March, 2025

In the convocation ceremony, Controller of Examinations Dr. Santigopal Pain made the formal announcements and the vote of thanks was given by Registrar Prof. Narendra Kumar Rana. During the fourth convocation, a total of 80 students who topped in undergraduate (UG) and postgraduate courses were awarded gold medals. For the year 2021, two students were awarded Chancellor Gold Medal, 10 (ten) students were awarded School Gold Medal while 26 students were awarded Department Gold Medal. For the year 2022, two (02) students were awarded Chancellor Gold Medal, 11 students were awarded School Gold Medal and 29 students were awarded Department Gold Medal. It is worth mentioning that a total of 80 students were awarded gold medals, out of which 59 gold medals were given to girl students while 21 gold medals were given to boys. Along with this, a total of 1346 students who passed Undergraduate (UG) and Post Graduate (PG) and PhD in the year 2021 and 2022 were awarded degree certificates by the university.

Dr Sumit Kumar Pathak, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Political Studies of CUSB presented his paper in the International Conference on "Reimagining Neutrality and its Research" organised by Kyoto University, Japan under Neutrality Studies Project during 23 to 25th October, 2024. Dr Pathak presented his paper titled "Revisiting Kautilya: Exploring Neutrality in Contemporary world' based on Indian Knowledge System. His study stands for a crucial attempt to challenge the Eurocentrism ideas that pervades the discipline of International Relations by examining the contributions of Kautilya and his seminal work, the Arthashastra. By exploring the strategic insights i.e. Neutrality presented in the Arthashastra (2500 years ago), this study aims to illuminate alternative perspectives on power dynamics & statecraft. "The idea of Neutrality can be traced back during 321-296 B.C in the writing of Kautilya's Arthashastra".

Law students 3rd Runner up in 1st Atal Bihari Vajpayee National Moot Court Competition, October 03-06, 2024


