Subject: Clarification on CUET (UG) 2025 score considered for admission to UG Programmes of CUSB

It is hereby informed that candidates registered for admission to Undergraduate Programmes of the Central University of South Bihar (CUSB) for the Academic Year 2025–26 must note that the programme-wise cut-off marks announced by the University are based strictly on the specific subject(s) / combination of subjects prescribed for each programme at the time of applying for CUET (UG) 2025.

As per CUET (UG) 'Information Bulletin' notified by National Testing Agency (NTA), candidates could have appeared in upto five subjects. However, for admission to a particular UG programme at CUSB, the University had clearly notified the required subject or subject combinations, both at the time of applying for CUET (UG) 2025 and again through the Admission Notification dated 14.07.2025.

It has come to notice that several candidates are computing their total CUET score by adding marks from all subjects they appeared in CUET (UG) 2025, and are comparing it with the cut-off announced by CUSB. However, this calculation does not form the basis for admission. Only the marks obtained in the specific subject(s) prescribed for the concerned programme are considered for calculating merit and determining eligibility.

Accordingly, the fee payment link has been activated only for candidates who:

- · have registered for admission within the stipulated timeline, and
- have secured equal to or above the prescribed cut-off marks in the specific subject(s) specified for a particular programme.

Candidates are advised to refer to the list of specified subject / combination of subjects required for admission in their chosen programme and check their CUET (UG) scores accordingly. Claims for admission based on aggregate scores across all subjects will not be considered.
