About the Gaya City

Gaya is a holy city beside the Falgu River, in the state of Bihar. It's known for 18th-century Vishnupad Mandir, a riverside temple with an octagonal shrine. Hindu devotees bath in a Brahma Kund pond before honoring their deceased ancestors atop Pretshila Hill. To the south lies the Buddhist center of Bodh Gaya. There are many interesting and historical places like Mahabodhi temple, Buddha statue, Tibetan refugee market, Bodhi tree for local sightseeing in Gaya. Historical towns like Nalanda and Rajgir are within 100 Km distance from Gaya.

How to Reach

- Gaya Airport is located 25 km from the Central University of South Bihar with domestic flights from major cities like Delhi and Kolkata; taxis and auto-rickshaws are available for the onward journey.
- Gaya Junction, a major railway station 15 km from the university, offers regular train services from various cities.
- By road, Gaya is well-connected via national highways, and you can take long-distance buses or drive from nearby cities like Patna (100 km).
